## Welcome to the Certified Nurse Assistant Program

The Certified Nurse Assistant (CNA) is an important member of the healthcare team who assists the nurse with the care of patients in skilled nursing facilities, home health agencies, clinics, and hospitals.

The Nursing Assistant Certificate includes 226 hours of lecture, skills lab, and clinical practice. The program is offered Spring, Summer, and Fall for 10 weeks, 3 - 4 days/ week. The course is limited to 30 students each semester. Upon successful completion of the course, the student will be eligible to take the State Certification exam for licensure.

The Santa Rosa Junior College Certified Nursing Assistant Program is accredited by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH).
